## Northfield Public Schools (ISD #659) has answers:

One of the milestones of a child's development is early childhood screening. This is a free service provided by Northfield Public Schools.

Minnesota requires all children attending kindergarten in a public school complete a screening. Ideally, children should be screened as soon as possible after their third birthday in order to identify potential health and development concerns.

Make a screening appointment if:	Areas screened:
