

# Questions on Early Childhood Screening?



Northfield Public Schools (ISD #659) has answers:

One of the milestones of a child's development is early childhood screening. This is a free service provided by Northfield Public Schools.

Minnesota requires all children attending kindergarten in a public school complete a screening. Ideally, children should be screened as soon as possible after their third birthday in order to identify potential health and development concerns.

<b>Make a screening appointment if:</b>	<b>Areas screened:</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• You are new to the district.</li><li>• Your child is 3 years old and has not been screened.</li><li>• You have concerns about a child who is younger than 3 years old.</li><li>• Your child is entering kindergarten in the fall and has not been screened.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Vision</li><li>• Hearing</li><li>• Growth</li><li>• Immunization status</li><li>• Development</li></ul>
